Short Description of Instrument:	<p>The Wide-Range Achievement Test (WRAT-4) measures basic academic skills such as: reading, mathematics and spelling necessary for effective learning, communication and thinking.</p> <p>Material is read by subject. Requires minimal training. Administration time is 10 minutes.</p> <p>Reading recognition has been identified as a brief, but effective, measurement of academic skills and intelligence that is not impacted by TBI in most cases</p> <p>The Word Reading Subtest measures letter naming and identification and word pronunciation and recognition</p>
